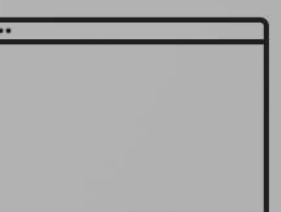

## FUNDRAISING:

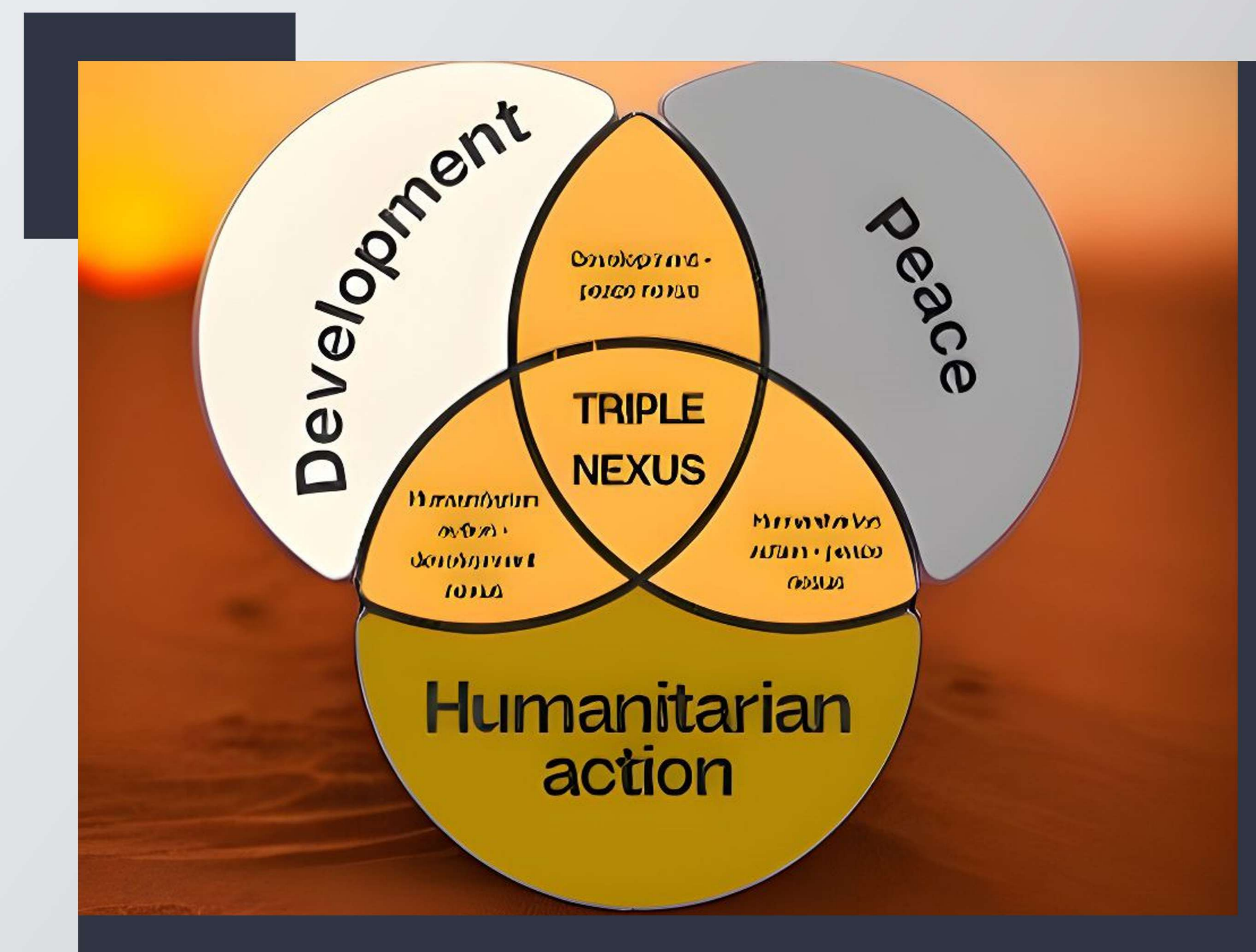
Seeking donations from the local and international donors and raising funds to finance activities and projects.

## PRINCIPLE:

### DEFINITION AND APPLICATION:

The "Triple Nexus" principle represents the close connection among three main areas: humanitarian, sustainable development, and peacebuilding. This approach aims to enhance cooperation and coordination among these areas to ensure comprehensive and sustainable crisis responses.





# HUMANITARIAN:

Humanitarian action focuses on providing immediate relief to communities affected by (such as wars or civil unrest) and natural disasters (like earthquakes, floods, or hurricanes), including the providing food, water, shelter, and basic healthcare.

It seeks to enhance peace and stability through conflict resolution initiatives, promoting the rule of law, and supporting dialogue and peaceful coexistence among different societal groups.







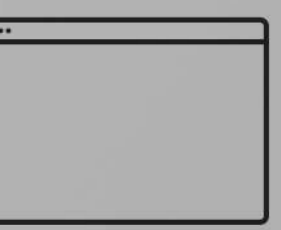

## CORE VALUES OF THE ASSOCIATION:

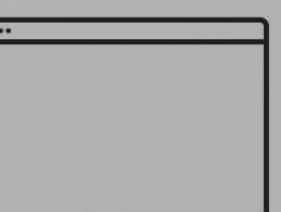
**Dignity:** Respecting human dignity in all interventions.
